Tahltan Nation Development Corporation (TNDC) provides heavy construction, equipment contracting and camp services (via Spatsizi Remote Services) to industries operating in Tahltan Traditional Territory.

TNDC is seeking reliable and enthusiastic individuals to join our team for the upcoming 2019 season, during the period of approximately April 1st to September 30th, 2019. For some positions, employment may begin before April 1st and/or extend beyond September 30th.

Business units, sites, departments in which personnel are required:

- Dease Lake facility – maintenance shop, yard, office, warehouse, other.
- Construction and other roles at the Red Chris Mine, and other operations.
- Construction projects on various sites inside and outside Tahltan Territory.
- Camp services (SRS division).
- Exploration projects (SRS and Construction divisions).
- Other locations and sites.
- Flexibility on work location and schedule is required.

Who should apply?

- TNDC invites all interested candidates to apply.
- Candidates with experience, certifications and qualifications are always sought.
- *TNDC encourages applications from individuals with little or no work experience, as training will be provided.*
- TNDC welcomes applications from students who are seeking to gain work experience.
- Minimum age requirements and qualifications will apply to some positions.
- **Tahltan members are encouraged to apply.**

Conditions of Employment include:

- Commitment to a safe work environment and safe work practices.
- Must be able to pass an alcohol and drug test.
- Applicants must be able to physically perform various duties, which may include:
 - sitting or standing for extended periods of time.
 - performing tasks in extreme weather conditions.
 - performing tasks that involve repetitive movements, bending, heavy lifting, cleaning, sweeping, shoveling, pounding, scraping, use of tools.
 - other duties as required.
- Valid driver's license preferred, but not required for all positions.
- Ability to take direction and follow instructions.
- Ability to communicate effectively and respectfully with supervisors and co-workers.
- Ability to work independently and cooperatively as part of a team.



- Ability to adapt to changing priorities and multi-task.
- Reliable and dependable – must be able to arrive for work on-time and ready for the job.
- Work schedules vary, depending on the position, site and project. This includes:
 - Monday to Friday, 40 hours per week.
 - Camp-based rotation - may require 10-12 hours per day, with 7-14 days in, followed by scheduled days off.
 - Part-time.
 - Willing to work overtime, including weekends.
 - Travel and overnight stays.
 - Flexibility on work location and schedule is required.
