Responsibilities

- investigating deficiencies and equipment malfunctions
- following maintenance procedures to ensure all equipment meets specifications
- cleaning, lubricating, and performing other routine maintenance work on equipment
- servicing attachments and working tools as required
- ensuring proper reporting, documentation, and clear lines of communication with supervisors
- attending toolbox, safety and other meetings or discussions as required
- participating in any other specified training
- other related duties as required
