- Conduct Environmental Risk Assessments and Impact Assessments and prepare project-specific environmental control plans, as required.
- Commit to training and educating staff on environmental issues with specific focus on water quality, habitat conservation, protection of flora and fauna from invasive species, fisheries resources, and wildlife interaction.
- Meet environmental requirements defined by the board of directors, legislation, regulation, government directives, standards, best practices, and other applicable environmental standards.
- Integrate environmental protection into our business by planning activities to avoid or mitigate adverse environmental impacts including climate change.
- Ensure that Joint Venture partnerships, subcontractors and their employees understand and adhere to TNDCs environmental policy and procedures.
- Conserve resource use by efficient use of energy, by reduction of emissions and discharges, eliminating unnecessary waste and recycling where practical.
- Ensure that response to any environmental incidents associated with TNDCs operations is swift and effective; and
- Develop a culture of continual improvement of our environmental performance and environmental management systems.
